The City of No More

1. What did the Apostle Peter say this present earth was destined for (2 Peter 3:10-13)? According to this promise, what are we looking for (2 Peter 3:13)?
2. What did John see in his final vision (Revelation 21:1)? What will come down to this new and purified heaven and earth (Rev 21:2)?
3. Who will dwell in the midst of this new heaven and earth with all the saints (Rev 21:3)?
4. What will there be “NO MORE OF” (Rev 21:4)? Who alone can make this happen (Rev 21:5)?
5. Who will live in the new heaven according to Rev 21:6? What do they “thirst” for (Matt 5:6, John 4:13-14; 7:37-39)? Who “overcomes” (Rev 21:7; 1 Jn 5:4-5)?

6. What does the “new heavenly Jerusalem” look like (Rev 21:10-23)? Does it have dimensions and building material? Where will its illumination come from (Rev 21:23)? Will there be any need for fossil fuels or nuclear power?

7. Notice that the material the city is built out of is multicolored but all translucent so that light can shine through (Rev 21:18-21). Do you think this city is built to perfectly reflect and refract the brilliance of the glory of God? Will there be any need for the sun or the moon (v 23)? Will there be any night (v 25)?

8. Where will the “water of life” come from (Rev 22:1)? Where did we last see the “tree of life” that John saw in Rev 22:2 (Genesis 3:22)?

9. What will the resurrected saints (called bond-servants) do in heaven (Rev 22:3-5)? What did Jesus tell His disciples about serving, reigning and judging (Matt 19:28, 1 Cor 6:2, Rev 3:21, 2 Timothy 2:12, Romans 8:17)?

10. To whom does He promise a blessing to in Rev 22:7? How should we “heed the words of this prophecy”? Does verse 10 sound like this message should be spread? What request did John add to Jesus’ words in 22:20? John was ready, what about you?
