The Central Characters in the Tribulation

Revelation 10-11:14 is another interlude which separates the Trumpet judgments from the bowl judgments. The seventh trumpet will sound in Rev 11:15, marking the pouring out of the last series of bowl judgments which immediately precede the second coming of Christ. These judgments will be so severe that if Christ didn't return to end them no one would survive.

1.	Rev 10 is John's vision of judgment that is so severe that he is told what (10:4)? When he symbolically ate the "little book" of judgments, what did it taste like and what did it do (10:9-10)? Compare this to 2 Cor 2:14-16.	
2.	In Rev 11:1-2, how long will God give control of the new Temple in Jerusalem to the "nations" i.e. the Gentiles? According to 2 Thessalonians 2:3-4, who will set himself up in the Temple and claim the worship due only to the true God?	
3.	Will God's people remain silent during this 3-1/2 years (Rev 11:3-6)? Who will speak for God and against "the man of lawlessness"? Considering the power God will give them, who do these "two witnesses" resemble (2 Kings 1:10, 1 Kings 17:1, Exodus 7:14-17)?	
4.	In Rev 11:15, the seventh trumpet judgment sounds which signals the final bowl judgments after which Christ will return. What is the mood in heaven (11:15-17)? What is the mood on earth (11:18)? Why the difference?

6.	What will happen to the dragon, which will make him desperate and more active (12:9, 12, 13 Who will he persecute and try to wipe out (12:17)?		
7.	Rev 13 introduces us to the two major henchmen that the dragon will use to oppose God and up a "Counterfeit Trinity". Describe the beast. What will amaze his followers (13:3, 12)? Hong does God allow him to exercise authority (13:5)?		
8.		best the beast say about God (13:6)? Who does he try to wipe out (13:7)? Who will the beast (13:8)?	
9.		ll act as a prophet for the beast in order to deceive people into worshipping him (13:11-hat ruthless device will they use to force people to follow them (13:16-17)?
