

IUNE 9 • DEPARTURE

Our spiritual adventure begins as we depart from the U.S. for our long-awaited destination—Israel!

HORN OF HITTEM We will pass by the place where Saladin defeated the Crusaders

MOUNT ARBEL A breathtaking panorama of the Sea of Galilee and the biblical sites of Jesus' public ministry.

IUNE 12 • AROUND THE SEA OF GALILEE

CAPERNAUM We will walk the streets of the adopted city of Jesus that witnessed so many of His miracles.

GALILEE BOAT This boat dates back to the time of Christ.


PETER'S The traditional place where Christ prepared a meal for His **PRIMACY** disciples and where He asked Peter, "Do you love me?"

IUNE 13 • ISRAEL'S NORTHERN BORDER

A beautiful nature reserve provides our backdrop as we visit

ANCIENT DAN this ancient Israeli city and see where wicked King Jeroboam set up a golden calf.

BANIAS WATERFALL A breathtaking spot where the headwaters of the Jordan River spill over.

CAESAREA PHILIPPI This is where Peter made his great profession, "Thou art the Christ, the Son of the living God."

NIMROD'S CASTLE We will climb the mountainside to this old Crusader fortress.

GOLAN HEIGHTS We will learn about Israel's struggles with Syria and Lebanon and discover why this area is so strategic.

JUNE 14 • THE JORDAN VALLEY

MOUNT TABOR Where Deborah and Barak led the forces of Israel to victory.

BET SHE'AN These Roman ruins sit in the shadow of the hill where the Philistines displayed the bodies of King Saul and his sons.

JERICHO The ancient Canaanite city where the "walls came tumbling down."

DEAD SEA The lowest point on the face of the earth.

JUNE 15 • THE WILDERNESS & UP TO JERUSALEM

We will ride a cable-car up to Herod's lavish palace/fortress

MASADA where Jewish zealots made their final stand in their revolt
against Rome.

EN GEDI One of the places where David encountered Saul.

QUMRAN The caves where the Dead Sea Scrolls were discovered.

UP TO
We will journey up to Jerusalem.

MOUNT Scopus From this vantage point, we will have an introduction to the magnificent city of Jerusalem.

WESTERN WALL We will go to the Old City and watch the orthodox Jews usher in Shabbat.













IUNE 16 • THE MESSIAH

MOUNT OF OLIVES At this panoramic vista, we are reminded of what Christ saw as He looked out over the city.

Dominus Flevit We will walk down Palm Sunday Road and stop at the place where Jesus wept over Jerusalem.

 $\begin{array}{l} \textit{GARDEN OF} \\ \textit{GETHSEMANE} \end{array} \textit{Here, amongst the ancient olive trees, is where Jesus was betrayed.}$

JERUSALEM MODEL This display will give us an excellent visual of the city as it looked during Jesus' time.

SHRINE OF THE BOOK Here we will see the Dead Sea Scrolls and other highlights of biblical archaeology.

St. Peter IN The traditional site of Caiaphas' House.

UPPER ROOM This is where Jesus and the disciples partook of the Last Supper.

HEZEKIAH'S CITY WALL We will wind through the narrow streets and colorful bazaars of the Old City, stopping along the way & THE CARDO to discover history that proves our faith.

IUNE 17 • THE OLD CITY

HERODIUM This fortress was built by Herod the Great and eventually became his burial place.

SOUTHERN TEMPLE STEPS A place where you can actually say, "I walked today where Jesus walked."

THE CITY OF DAVID

Starting from King David's palace, we will see Warren's Shaft, Gihon Spring which may be the waterspout through which David's forces climbed to capture the city, and the Pool of Siloam where the blind man, after encountering Jesus, washed the mud off his eyes and received his sight. Those interested can also walk through Hezekiah's Tunnel.

JUNE 18 • THE PASSION OF THE CHRIST

THE TEMPLE View the ancient site of the Temple, now holding **MOUNT** the Dome of the Rock and the Al Aksa Mosque.

POOL OF BETHESDAThe pool where Jesus healed a sick man.

St. Anne's This old Crusader church's amazing acoustics
CHURCH will enhance any group's songs of praise.

ANTONIO'S The place where the soldiers mocked Jesus **FORTRESS** and placed a crown of thorns on His head.

VIA DOLOROSA We will travel along the "Way of the Cross" until we reach the Church of the Holy Sepulcher.

THE GARDEN TOMB

We will walk into an ancient tomb similar to the one in which Christ was buried and then have a communion service celebrating the resurrection of our Savior..."He is not here! He has risen!"
